Sub: Non implementation of DOT's Order No 2-49(3)/2009-PAT dated 4.11.2010 to allow pay fixation of the Group B Officers absorbed in BSNL who have opted for IDA pay scale from the date of their promotion after 1.10.2000 – Cases under Principal CCA, Kolkata

Sir,

We are constraint to encroach upon your valuable time to seek redressal of a long pending grievance of some absorbed BSNL pensioners in Kolkata who are being denied their pension on the scale in which they retired from service and also refund of a portion of DCRG amount which was unjustly with held by the Principal CCA, Kolkata. These pensioners, on their absorption in BSNL, had opted for IDA pay scale on their promotion after 1.10.2000 as per terms and conditions of service for absorption. Since some doubts were raised on the applicability of this option for opting IDA pay scale, the Director (TE) of DoT Headquarters had issued an order vide his No 2-49(3)/2009-PAT dated 4.11.2010 directing all the Pr CCAs/CCAs to provisionally allow pay fixation of the Group B Officers absorbed in BSNL who had opted for IDA pay scale from the date of their promotion after 1.10.2000 subject to submission of a Bond by such pensioners.

2 But, it is regretted to inform you sir, that the Principal CCA, Kolkata is not implementing the above quoted instruction of DoT Headquarters which was issued more than one and half years back. As a result, the concerned pensioners are being paid less pension amount than what is due to them for the last several years. Further, these pensioners are not being refunded the withheld portion of their DCRG. Thus, these pensioners are being harassed and tortured both financially and mentally.

3 We would, therefore, seek for your immediate kind intervention so that the Principal CCA, Kolkata is directed to implement the above quoted DoT Order dated 4.11.2010 without any further delay so that the ordeal of these hapless pensioners comes to an end.
