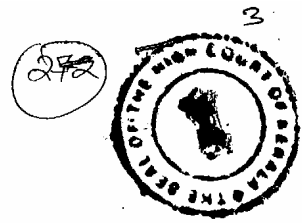

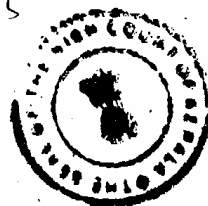

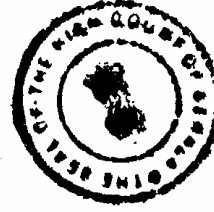

Judgment

Since the very same point is raised for decision in all these Writ Petitions, they are heard and disposed of by this common judgment.

Writ Petition (C) No.8245/05

2. This Writ Petition is treated as the main case. The brief facts of the case are the following : The petitioners are either Divisional Engineers or Sub Divisional Engineers under the BSNL. Their seniority in the cadre of Sub Divisional Engineer is the subject matter of this Writ Petition. All of them were promoted along with others as Sub Divisional Engineers by Ext.P1 order dated 21.10.1998. Altogether, 3629 Junior Telecom Officers were promoted to the cadre of Sub Divisional Engineer by Ext.P1. Relying on the claim of the respondents in paragraph 1 (x) of Ext.P9 affidavit, the petitioners point out that at the relevant time, 4200 vacancies were available in the cadre of SDOT. The recruitment rules governing appointing to the said post were amended with effect from 22.07.1996. It is common case that the vacancies which arose before the said date were to be filled up in accordance with the erstwhile recruitment rules issued in 1981. But the unqualified seniors on the said date,

felt aggrieved by the promotion of so many persons who were juniors to them to the vacancies which were available as on 22.07.1996. So, some of the seniors filed two OAs before the CAT Bangalore bench. The said bench quashed Ext.P10 order dated 15.10.1998, which created 1966 posts of SDOT with retrospective effect from 15.10.1993. The retrospectivity given to that order was challenged by the unqualified seniors who were aspiring for promotion, in 1998. They contended that those vacancies can come into existence only prospectively. The said contention was accepted by the CAT and the retrospectivity given to the creation of 1966 posts w.e.f. 15.10.1993 was quashed by the CAT, Bangalore bench. Based on the reduction of those vacancies, the respondents swung into action and immediately cancelled Ext.P1 promotion order by Ext.P12 order. They felt that there may not be sufficient vacancies available to accommodate 3629 incumbents promoted under Ext.P1. Apparently, that was the reason for the reaction of the respondents manifested by Ext.P12.

3. The petitioners attacked Ext.P12, contending that there were 4200 vacancies available before 22.07.1996 and they were promoted to 3629 vacancies out of them and so the quashing of the retrospectivity given to the

creation of 1966 vacancies will not affect them. The competent authority published Exts.P14 and P16 consequential seniority lists also pursuant to Ext.P12. So, the OA was filed, challenging Exts.P12, P14 and P16, based on the aforementioned grounds. Though the respondents have filed a counter affidavit, the above points raised by the writ petitioners are not specifically met in the said counter affidavit.

4. I heard the learned counsel on both sides. The learned Senior Counsel Shri.O.V.Radhakrishnan reiterated the aforementioned contentions of the writ petitioners. The learned Standing Counsel for the BSNL Shri.Mathews.K.Philip submitted that Ext.P12 interim order was issued subject to the orders that may be passed in certain Writ Petitions pending before this Court. It is submitted that those Writ Petitions mentioned in Ext.P12 were subsequently disposed of directing the BSNL to publish fresh seniority lists in accordance with law. It is also pointed out that steps are being taken to publish a fresh seniority list. The learned counsel also pointed out that Exts.P14 and P16 are only draft seniority lists and they cannot affect the rights of the writ petitioners.

5. In view of the contentions raised by the writ petitioners that the

reduction of 1966 vacancies in the cadre of SDOT will not affect their promotion, which is not seriously controverted, I am of the view that there is no justification for cancelling Ext.P1 by Ext.P12 order. Accordingly, Ext.P12 is quashed. But respondents 2 and 3 will be free to review the promotions granted to the vacancies which were available on 22.07.1996 with reference to the actual vacancies available and publish the seniority list with opportunity to affected persons to object to the same. In view of the quashing of Ext.P12, Exts.P14 and P15 cannot survive. Further, those lists are being replaced by a fresh list as submitted by the learned Standing Counsel for the BSNL. Therefore, Exts.P14 and P15 are also quashed. It is clarified that if there is dearth of vacancies as on 22.07.1996 to accommodate all promotees, the excess junior hands can be reverted.

6. The Judgment in Writ Petition (C) No.8245/05 shall be treated as the Judgment in these cases also.
